Harvest By hand to small cases of 15 Kg

Vinification After cold maceration, grapes are pressed

and fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks, with temperature control at

aprox 16°C.

Alcohol 13% vol.

Total acidity 6 g/l

<4 g/l

"Pretty pink" vibrant rose colour. This wine Tasting notes has an elegant bouquet of fresh

strawberries and raspberries and a hint of dried herbs. A more serious and fresh style of rose with a crisp yet smooth palate that unlike may rose wines finishes quite dry leaving you with want for another mouthful. Given this is a drier style of rose it is a great barbeque wine either by itself or with salmon, chicken and any number of

fresh salads.
