Grape varieties	Touriga Nacional and Cabernet Sauvignon
Region	Tejo
Soil	Poor and Sandy
Harvest	By hand to small cases of 15 kg
Vinification	After a pre-fermentative maceration, fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks, with temperature control.
Ageing	6 months in small oak barrels
Alcohol	13.5% vol.
Total acidity	5,5g/l
Residual sugar	< 4 g/l
Tasting notes	Deep garnet-red coloured wine. An elegant nose combining notes of ripe blue fruits and cedar spices. Round supple tannins confer structure and softness to the palate that shows ripe unctuous fruit qualities and wonderful length.
