Harvest	By hand to small cases of 15 kg
Vinification	After cold maceration, grapes are pressed and fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks, with temperature control at aprox 16°C.
Alcohol	13 % vol.
Total acidity	6 g/l
Residual sugar	< 4 g/l
Tasting notes	"Pretty pink" vibrant rose colour. This wine has an elegant bouquet of fresh strawberries and raspberries and a hint of dried herbs. A more serious and fresh style of rose with a crisp yet smooth palate that unlike may rose wines finishes quite dry leaving you with want for another mouthful. Given this is a drier style of rose it is a great barbeque wine either by itself or with salmon, chicken and any number of fresh salads. d maceration, grapes are pressed and fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks, with temperature control at aprox 16°C.
